Adult Mission OfferingRed Bird Mission

The Red Bird Mission has been providing ministries in this region of the Appalachian Mountains since 1921. Today the need remains critical in this isolated, rural distressed area. Chronic poverty, lack of jobs, poor housing, and rugged mountainous terrain provide obstacles to a fuller life for the residents of this area. Red Bird Mission and Clinic strives to meet these needs through ministry in five areas: Education, Health and Wellness, Community Outreach, Economic Opportunity, and Community Housing Improvement.

Children Mission Offering Liberia Scholarship

This months mission offering will go to the Liberia Scholarship Fund. We have been supporting 30 students (\$200 for each student) at the Tubman Gray United Methodist School in Liberia for several years. Each scholarship provides for school uniforms, supplies and teacher salary assistance.
